Rules and Responsibilities of being a member of the Toy Library

- The Toy Library is open from 8.30am to 4.00pm Monday to Friday.
- **Children must be supervised in the Toy Library at all times.**
- While in the library nothing is to be removed from bags or boxes and the room must be left tidy. Plus children must not climb on shelving or furniture.
- Only 3 toys plus 1 book or puzzle can be borrowed at any one time.
- Toys must be returned **clean** and **complete** within **2 weeks**, regular failure to do so may cause your membership to be suspended or withdrawn.
- Returned toys must be placed in the designated area (under the sink). Toys must never be taken from that area.
- Families will pay the cost of replacing lost toys, lost parts of toys or repairs of damaged toys.
- Families will supply all batteries required for toys and we ask that you take the batteries out before returning them as damage can be caused if batteries are left in.
- **Families must accept the responsibility of supervising the safe use of the toys while in their possession, by taking note of any warnings on items and taking care to see things are used safely.** This includes taking care with; batteries and small parts to avoid choking; plastic bags to avoid suffocation; long cords to avoid strangulation; and supplying protective clothing and helmets where applicable with ride on toys.

For Families living in the Waikato Region wishing to use our rural delivery service

- 3 Toys and 1 book or puzzle will be sent out to your home by courier. Included in the bag of toys will be a return courier ticket, an address label for the return trip and a comments sheet so you can let us know how useful the toys were so we can choose well for you next time.
- Toys must be returned, **clean** and **complete**, by courier or delivered into the Library within **4 weeks**.
- Once we have received them we will arrange to send out a new selection of toys.
- There must be a conversation with the Toy Librarian either in person or by telephone before the service can commence.
