**TE WHARE POIPOI** is a short term residential respite option for children and young people from birth to 16 years who have high and complex physical care needs. We offer:

- Planned respite in a caring, homely environment.
- Large, fully accessible five bedroom home.
- Fully fenced, secure section.
- Individual bedrooms.
- 24 hour care, 7 days a week.
- Van with hoist.
- Outdoor play area & equipment.
- Tactile play.
- Arts, crafts, music.
- Opportunity to access community activities.

## How to enter the service?

Ka pēhea te whai wāhi mai ki te ratonga?

**TE WHARE POIPOI** is open to children and young people who meet the disability criteria set by the Ministry of Health. Referral channels are through Disability Support Link in Waikato, and Support Net - Kupenga Hao I te Ora in the Bay of Plenty. Te Whare Poipoi staff offer a home visit to meet your family and learn about your child's needs and interests. Parents, caregivers and children are welcome to visit Te Whare Poipoi by arrangement. All children and young people have a care plan completed with parents/caregivers input.
